

College Rules for under 18s

THE LAW

(examples only)

Smoking

Under 16 years old? Do not smoke.

Under 18 years old? Do not buy cigarettes or tobacco.

Do not buy cigarettes or tobacco for under 18 year olds.

Crime - Alcohol

Under 18 years old? Do not buy cigarettes or alcohol.

Do not buy alcohol for under 18 year olds.

Crime – Drugs

All drugs are illegal. Do not take any drugs not from a pharmacy.

Crime - Weapons

Do not carry any sort of weapon. This includes knives and pepper sprays.

Crime - Stolen property

Do not buy property that you think may be stolen.

Crime - Theft in shops

Do not steal from shops!

Internet Safety

Read the Welcome booklet and follow the advice about internet safety and the law.

Bicycles

Under 16 - Do not ride a bicycle.

16 & 17 years old? Your parents have said you can? You can ride a bicycle..

Lessons

Please go to all lessons and be on time. If you cannot attend, call the College by 09.00.

If you are late, you will do work in the cafeteria.

Do not take food or drink into the classroom. Water is ok.

Do not chew gum in class.

Do not use your phone in class.

Do not behave badly. Be responsible and cooperative at all times.

Try to use English when inside the college.

Activities

Under 16? Stay under direct supervision at all times.

Obeys the instructions of the Group/Activity Leader at all times.

Wristbands

In the summer we will give you a wristband when you arrive and you will wear the correct wristband at all times on site or on activities.

Behaviour

You will be respectful to your host families, College staff and fellow students in the College.

All people at the College will respect the 4 main College values - democracy, the rule of law, the freedom of the individual and respect for and tolerance of other beliefs and faiths.

The College

Under 16? Do not leave the college grounds until the end of your day.

Do not climb on roofs.

Do not play in a noisy, dangerous or violent way while on College site.

Do not throw rubbish on the ground. Use the bins.

Homestay accommodation

Give your host your mobile telephone number.

If you are going out, tell your host where you are going and who you are going with.

If you are going to be late for a meal, please tell your host.

Respect your host family's routine.

Respect the College's curfew times (see below).
